

## KEY REGIONAL AG STATISTICS

The Colorado River supplies water to a unique climatic region of California & Yuma, AZ that generates agricultural production that is crucial to America's year-round domestic supply of fresh vegetables and other crops.



**95%** of winter lettuce, broccoli, cauliflower & leafy greens grown in Lower Basin



**24%** of California spinach grown in Imperial & Riverside Cos.



**22%** of all California lettuce grown in Imperial & Riverside Cos.



**29%** of California peppers grown in Coachella Valley



**33%** of California hay grown in Imperial Valley



**100%** of U.S. dates grown in Lower Basin
