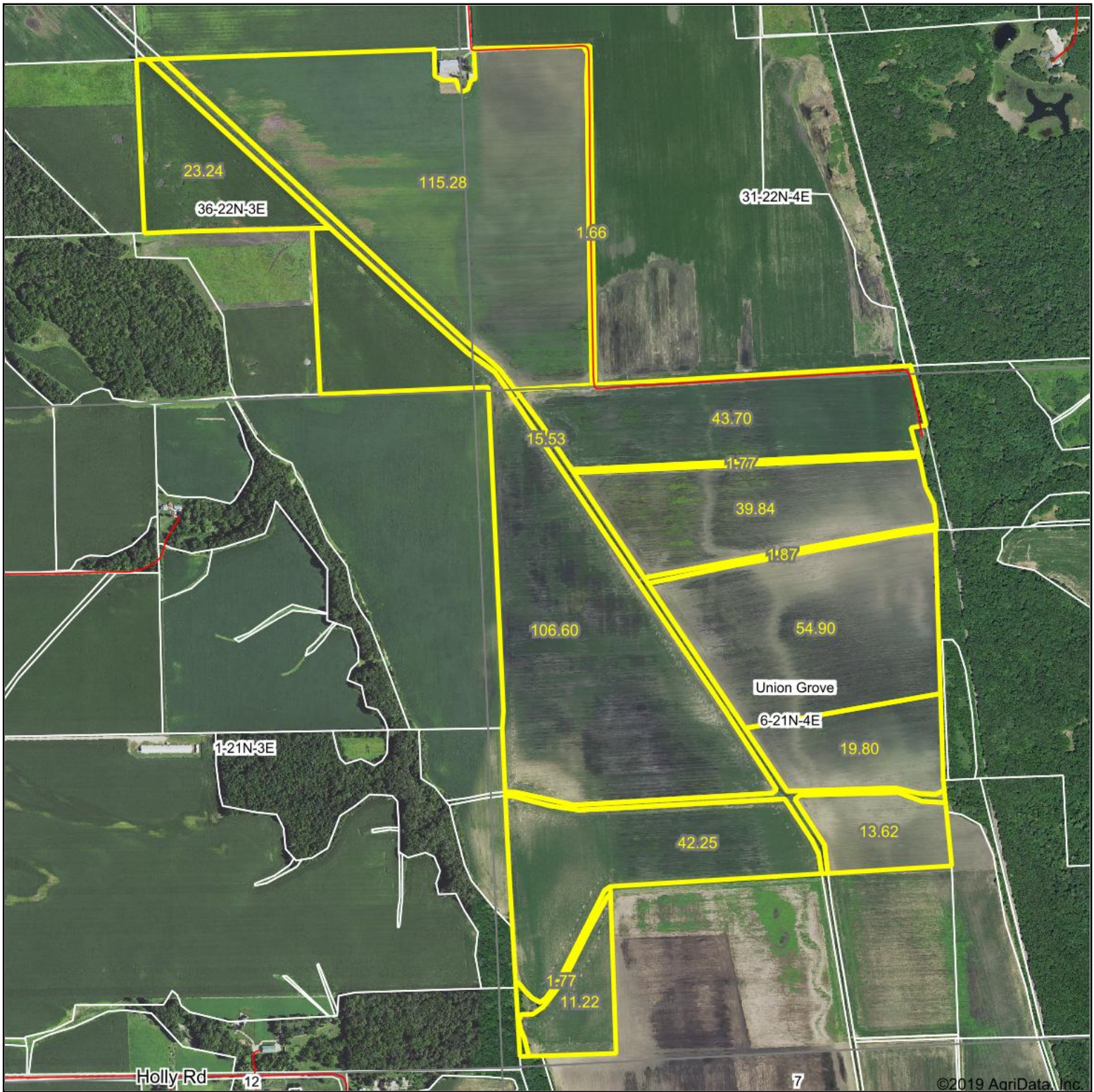

Aerial Map - Total Acres per Whiteside Co. FSA



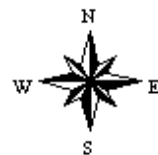

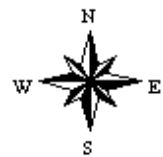
Aerial Map - Tillable Acres per Whiteside Co., FSA

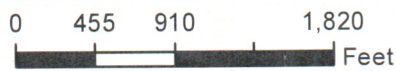
