Online Bidding: Register to bid at http://peoplescompany.bidwrangler. com/. Potential bidders may have access to the live auction by utilizing Peoples Company's online auction platform via the Internet. Auction Method: The tract will be offered via Public Auction and will take place at 10:00 AM at the National Sprint Car Hall of Fame & Museum in Knoxville, Iowa. The farmland tract will be sold on a per-acre basis through a traditional auction method. Closing: Closing will occur on or before Monday, May 15th, 2023. The balance of the purchase price will be payable at closing in the form of cash, guaranteed check, or wire transfer.

Possession: Possession of the land will be given At Closing.

Farm Lease: The farm is available for the 2023 cropping season.

Contract & Title: Immediately upon the conclusion of the auction, the high bidder will enter into a real estate sales contract and deposit with Peoples Company the required earnest money payment. The Seller will provide a current abstract at their expense. The sale is not contingent upon Buyer financing.
