THE STRUCTURES

TASTING ROOM

- · 2,893 square feet
- Unobstructed views of downtown Ashland overlooking the estate vineyard
- · Unlimited tastings, wine club and wine promotional events
- · Outdoor entertainment venue can accommodate up to 200 people
- The grounds include large patio, stage for music venue, bocce court, rose gardens and a fountain
- The tasting bar on the main floor is used for greeting guest plus has inside seating for 50 people
- · Prep kitchen to curate food pairings
- Three rooms with private bath set up as rentals for wine club members or special guests
- · ADA compliant

WINERY BUILDING (link to winery plans)

- Built in 2021
- · 3,840 square feet
- · Cold storage for barrels and dry goods
- · Additional plans for an expansion to create a gravity-flow winery

RESIDENCE

- · 2,236 square feet
- · 2 bedrooms with 2.5 baths
- · A pergola overlooking the three acre orchard is set up with an outdoor kitchen and bocce court
- · Large basement

BARN

- · 1,980 square feet
- · Used for vineyard and equipment storage
- · Has a one bedroom and one bath apartment





INFRASTRUCTURE

WELLS

- · Well on 1320 N Mountain = 2.5 gpm
- · Well on 1550 N Mountain = 20 gpm
- · Both wells serve as the domestic wells for the tasting room, winery building and residence
- \cdot A 1,500 gallon cistern is used for water storage to the tasting room

CANAL


- · Water rights granted by Talent Irrigation District (TID)
- · 2.64 feet of water per acre during the irrigation season which runs April thru mid-October
- · Used for vineyard irrigation

ELECTRICAL

- · 10kw wind powered generator
- · Sits atop a 120' tower
- · Produces 60% of the power demand from the property

THE LOCATION


- · Situated in the Rogue Valley AVA, a sub region of the Southern Oregon AVA, This region has similar wine growing characteristics to Bordeaux Dana Campbell Is part of the Bear Creek Wine Trail
