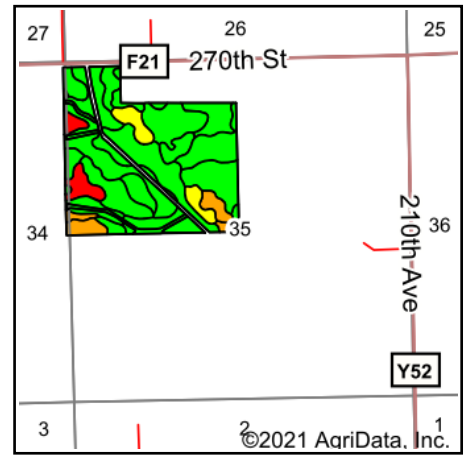
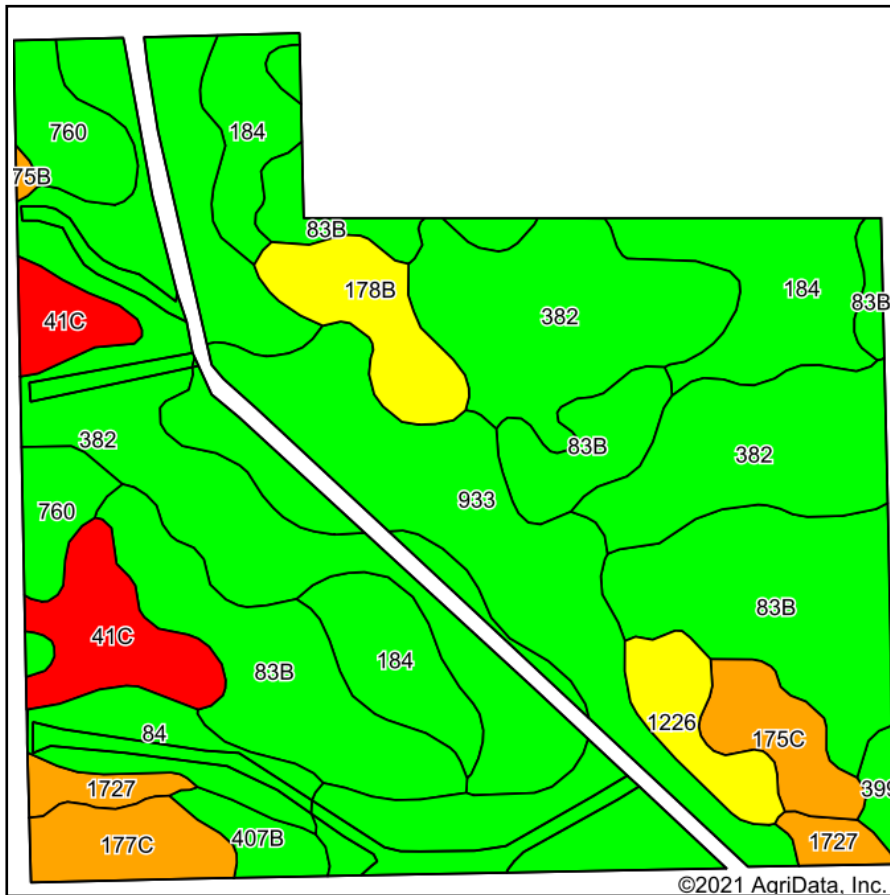


Soils Map - Tract 1 - Est. Tillable Acres
